

Our Annual Recognition Awards are designed to give recognition to member mentoring projects and individuals that have made a significant impact over the past year. The awards, now in their seventh year, are open to all members of Scottish Mentoring Network and Glasgow Mentoring Network.

Eligibility

- Any organisation that is a member of Scottish Mentoring Network / Glasgow Mentoring Network is eligible to apply for the Recognition Awards.
- An organisation with more than one mentoring project can, if they wish, submit an application form for each project.

Award Categories

Project of the Year Awards - Awards are categorised based on the various thematic areas that projects work in with awards given to the project that is deemed to be the best in its area. There will also be an award presented to the project that is considered to be the overall 'Project of the Year', regardless of the thematic area operating in.

Individual Awards - All projects that submit an application will be given the opportunity to nominate an individual mentor that has made a special contribution over the past year to receive recognition and their own award at the National Event.

Projects will also be given the opportunity to nominate a member of staff who has made an outstanding impact over the past year.

Assessment

- After the closing date for receipt of award application forms the assessment panel will meet to review all received applications and select the winning projects and individuals.

- The Deadline for submitting Award Applications is 12 noon on **Friday 13th October 2017**.
- The Winners will be presented at the SMN National Event at *St Paul's & St George's Church* in Edinburgh on *Wednesday 15th November 2017*. We ask anyone who submits an award application to send a representative along to the National Event to collect any award you may win.
