Coordinating Mentoring Programmes *Accredited at SCQF Level 7*

A 2 day course to enable those involved in planning and coordinating mentoring programmes, to develop and enhance their knowledge and understanding and to develop practical skills essential to coordinating mentoring programmes in a range of settings.

What does the course cover?

This course provides an opportunity to complete assessments to achieve an **SQA accredited unit in Mentoring.** This course sits at SCQF level 7 and has 8 SCQF credit points.

The 2 day course will look at:

- · Key principles and processes of mentoring
- Planning, coordinating and implementing mentoring programmes within organisations, with a focus on:
 - The planning process
 - o Recruiting, selecting, and matching mentors
 - o Good practice Guidelines for policies, procedures and legislative requirements
 - o Guiding, supporting, training and developing mentors
 - o Resources, recording and reporting
 - o Review, monitoring and evaluation strategies
- Benefits, advantages and limitations of mentoring programmes
- The mentoring relationship, roles, responsibilities and boundaries
- Understanding the role, skills and qualities of the mentor
- Practical sessions in conducting mentoring activities
- Action planning, progress reviews and development of mentoring activities with learners

Cost: £350.00

Course fee includes:
